MISS GOLDSBORO SCHOLARSHIP PAGEANT
Scholarship Rules and Regulations
Effective July 1, 2012
Revised Nov. 10, 2016

1. Scholarship funds may be used for tuition and room and board at an accredited University, college, or technical school.
2. Scholarships may be used for current educational expenses
3. Scholarships may be used for outstanding student loan obligations.
4. To receive your scholarship funds, you should submit a statement of your account for the current semester from your school or a statement from the lending institution that holds your student loan. Scholarship funds will be made payable to your school or loan institution. Checks will not be made to an individual. All requests for payment of funds must be accompanied by a cover letter from the contestant. Mail request to: Miss Goldsboro Scholarship Association, Attn: Executive Director, 208 N. Church Street, Fremont, NC 27830
5. Scholarship funds must be requested within one year of completion of your title date as Miss Goldsboro.
6. Scholarships that have been forfeited will remain in the scholarship account for future awards.
7. No cash settlement will be made to any recipient.
8. Should a runner-up succeed to the title of Miss Goldsboro or succeed any place higher than she originally placed, she is still only eligible to receive the amount of scholarship money awarded to her at the Miss Goldsboro Scholarship Pageant.
9. Scholarships won at the local level must be paid prior to applying for a state scholarship. When requesting state scholarship funds, a letter from the Miss Goldsboro Scholarship Pageant Committee Executive Director verifying that local scholarship funds have been paid must accompany the request.
10. The granting of scholarship funds is subject to the terms and conditions of the scholarship rule and regulations. The current Miss Goldsboro may request her scholarship monies at anytime during her reign.
